Chile Promotes Naturism Tourism

by Hosting Regional Conference in 2012

We all know naturism has a worldwide appeal, but we tend to focus on being a marginalized minority without clout or a means to boldly promote ourselves. Probably Latin America is not on our radar as a haven for naturists. Yet, naturists in Chile are making waves ... big ones!

Naturists in Chile have landed an international naturist conference and are working with the Chile Convention Bureau to promote it. Further, part of the big picture is the anticipation of the benefits to the local economy deriving from a gathering of naturists.

Chilean naturists are to be commended for taking on such a huge enterprise. There will be a lot of work, but with great rewards. It will provide the opportunity to educate the public about naturist values and likely attract many new participants to naturism who otherwise wouldn't think about giving nude recreation a try. Bravo! [Ed.]

"This nomination allows us to promote Chile as a destination for the tourism business, just as we have focused campaigns in Latin America and Europe," said Carolina Bugmann, head of the Chile Convention Bureau, which is part of the private business Turismo Chile.

Over 5,000 people have registered with Chile's Nudism-Naturism Association, headquartered in the Luna beach area near Valparaíso.

"The development of international tourism meetings also brings other benefits, as promotional efforts have a multiplying effect and generate jobs and businesses, on top of additional spending by tourists," Bugmann said. Organizers are looking to attract businesses to sponsor the event.

"We have a lot of work to do for the summit, because we're interested in every type of request so that Chile remains on a good foot," explained René Rojas, who has been president of the Chilean Nudism-Naturism Association for 12 years..

Minorities In Naturism

A number of years ago I was visiting Glen Eden nudist resort in Southern California during a large AANR sponsored meeting. The grounds were crowded with people engaged in the things everyone does to enjoy a day nude at a resort. People were engaged in water volleyball, tennis, regular volleyball, lounging in the large hot tub and of course, lots of people sunning around the large and well used pool.

While the majority of participants were Caucasian, there was a sprinkling of people of color and Asian origin. It was a welcome sign and added to the enjoyment of the day.

Most people weren't out the next morning which allowed plenty of room to take a long swim. Finishing my work-out, I noticed someone I hadn't seen before who happened to be African American. We exchanged greetings and I swam a few more laps.

After swimming I approached this gentleman as he had been sufficiently warm in his greeting I felt he wouldn't mind some conversation. After further introductions we discovered a common interest – Nebraska football! As it turned out he had been a house parent in the group home a well known Husker football player had grown up in. Wow, unbelievable!

From time to time Lake Edun has been host to minority participants. Sadly, this hasn't been in any great numbers or on a regular basis. I hope this can change. After all, naturism is about body acceptance – all bodies – regardless of racial and ethnic origin.

Growing naturism is always a challenging task. Anyone coming to naturism has to be a person with some willingness to take a risk. At the same time, we at Lake Edun need to make it explicit that all people are welcome. As members, we can support this with a sincere and friendly greeting to all our guests. This is what makes people willing to return.

As it turns out, a really helpful podcast from Bareoaks naturist club in Canada focuses on this topic. The 40 minute podcast features two naturists discussing their minority participation in naturism, with suggestions for recruiting more minorities to naturism. It's a good listen. BLM Establishes New Rules for Some Tracts

Naturist outdoors lovers rejoice! The Bureau of Land Management's California Desert District this week issued new regulations for public nudity that specify where nudists may hike, camp and fish on public lands.

The final supplementary rules came in response to concerns from the American Association for Nude Recreation that BLM's interim rules issued last summer, which banned nudity at "developed sites" and areas open to off-highway vehicles, were too vague and could allow nudists to inadvertently enter developed areas.

The new rules clarify that wilderness areas, which cover well over a million acres in the district, are open for nude recreation as long as there are not large groups of people.

The new rules prohibit nudity near campsites with picnic tables, toilet facilities or visitors centers, in addition to off-highway vehicle trails, BLM said.

Diving With Whales

Braving sub-zero temperatures, she has thrown caution — and her clothes — to the wind to tame two beluga whales in a unique and controversial experiment.

To test the theory that belugas do not like to be touched by artificial materials such as diving suits, Natalia Avseenko, 36, was persuaded to dive naked among the whales.

The skilled Russian diver took the plunge as the water temperature hit minus 1.5 degrees Centigrade. The photographs were taken in the far north-west of Russia at the shore of the White Sea near the Arctic Circle.

An area of the sea is enclosed to stop whales and dolphins from getting out and instructors tame the mammals before they are transported to dolphinariums around the world — a practice many animal conservationists consider cruel.

The average human could die if left in sub-zero temperature sea water for just five minutes. However, Natalia is a yoga expert and used meditation techniques to hold her breath and stay under water for an incredible ten minutes and 40 seconds.

We would like you to take as much care for yourself as possible! Of course! It's part of loving yourself; caring about yourself.

This blog is about loving your body **wherever you are in life**, healthy, not healthy, or working on it, **you deserve to be body positive and never self-loathe**.

I understand that people have concerns about physical health in accordance to weight, but that does not justify criticizing, bullying, or shaming people for their bodies."

To reinforce this conviction followers of the blog have a manifesto of their core beliefs. These are as follows:

THE BEAUTY REVOLUTION OATH

By following this blog, I am making a promise.

I promise that this is the first step in loving myself, all myself.

I promise never to insult someone else merely for their appearance, everyone is different, everyone is beautiful in their own way.

I promise to stop insulting myself, to stop assuming I am not good enough or pretty enough.

I promise to look up, think positively, know that no matter what, I deserve happiness.

I promise to not be influenced by weight-loss ads, the media, my relatives, my friends, my significant others, ANYONE, into thinking that there is a RIGHT way for me to look.

I promise not to change for anyone else. If someone truly loves me, they will love me no matter how I look.

I promise to stop denying I am beautiful, to start saying "Thank you. You are beautiful as well."

I promise to remember: I am a human being and no matter what I look like, as long as I have a beautiful soul, I AM a beautiful person.

BE BRAVE! JOIN THE REVOLUTION!

I like it! What's more, there are hundreds of young people that have responded, sending in their pictures and the stories of their struggles. They share their struggles with weight, anorexia, self injury, teasing, bullying, suicide attempts, abuse, etc. Most responding are females, but a few males have also sent in their stories. Naked wedding photos are the hot new trend among young couples in once deeply conservative China to the fury of their parents' generation. One irate woman from the Anhui capital says, "I hope the authorities will do something."

She had just found out that her daughter had taken two sets of wedding photos, one to show the family, and another considerably more intimate one for her private collection. And her daughter isn't alone, it appears nude wedding photos is a growing trend that began in the south of China and has gradually spread to the rest of the country.

Some in the local media seemed to think that the photos are a welcome renewal to the stale unchanging traditions of the wedding photo. This attitude is now prevalent even in north-west China's proud ancient capital to the terracotta soldiers.

"Most of the people who come here to have the bold, naked photos taken are young, trendy and unconventional", said a studio owner. He did mention that, in most cases, the photos were carefully taken to avoid displaying full-frontal nudity.

Well, the irate mom above has had her request acted upon. In November a trade association for wedding photographers in China called for a ban on naked portraits of newlyweds, a new trend among the country's young couples. The Shanghai Wedding Trade Association said the practice disrespects the institution of marriage and warned it would press the government to ban any studio that takes such photos, the Shanghai Daily reported today.

"We don't advocate such wedding photographs as they are out of keeping with the conservative traditions of Chinese people," the association's vice president said.

While there was nothing illegal about taking naked portraits, a lawyer informed the newspaper that anyone who spreads such photos in the public domain could face pornography charges.

Samples of purported naked wedding photos have been posted on the Internet, prompting a debate over privacy and the wisdom of posing nude.

Fans of the photos say they capture a couple's deep love and intimacy.
