SAUNA – A Finnish National Institution

"There is nothing that Finns have been as unanimous about as their sauna. This unanimity has remained unbroken for centuries and is sure to continue as long as there are children born in their native land, as long as the invitation comes from the porch threshold in the evening twilight:

'The sauna is ready'." - Maila Talvio 1871-1951

Finland is the land of the sauna and the Finns are a nation of sauna-enthusiasts. With a population of 5.1 million, there are 1.7 millions saunas in Finland. However, sauna is not a Finnish invention, nor are Finns the only users of the sauna. Over the course of centuries many nations have practices sweat bathing. How long there has been sauna is unclear, but the current Finnish practice goes back to somewhere in the 5th to 8th century. The practice of several

periods of repeated perspiring in the heat and steam, known as loyly which is a Finno-Ugric word going back 7,000 years.

In Finland, a whole culture has grown up around sauna, but has not been wholly followed as the sauna has spread to other parts of the world. No matter. The rest of us recognize a good thing when we see it.

One of the wonderful assets of Lake Edun is our sauna. Several Eduners have made frequent use of the sauna, enjoying its benefits of relaxation and fellowship. Others may ignore its existence or seldom take the time to participate.

With the Finns we can end the week with a sauna, get a renewed sense of well being and recovery from the week's toils. Several hundred scientific papers have been published documenting the response of the human body to sauna. It will please all to know that there is little to indicate any health risk from sauna. The cardiac load from sauna is similar to that seen during brisk walking. Fluid loss is easily replaced by drinking a couple of glasses of water. The only caution is with young children who must be able to express discomfort understandably. The time they spend in a sauna needs to be reduced. In Finland 95% of children have their first sauna before age two, and are also among the healthiest in the world.

The pleasures of the sauna are that it cleanses and heals the body, soothes the mind, and provides agreeable sensations and many other pleasures. The cleansing of the body is fairly obvious. A good sweat and a shower cleanses the skin better than normal. Healing comes to tight or sore muscles. Soothing and relaxation of the mind is frequently experienced during sauna. Finally, altered perception of time is noticed by many who report the sensation of time standing still in the sauna. After the sauna there is no hurry anywhere. The feeling is blissful. 'Recreated' best describes what the refreshed mind feels.

There are no rules about how long you should stay in the loyly, or how many times warming up and cooling off should be repeated. Everyone should do exactly what feels good. The time to stay in the heat depends on the temperature, humidity, and the individual. Some people are happy with one or two rounds, while others go on for hours.

In Finland the most popular ways to cool off are to swim in a lake or the sea if possible, and in winter, rolling in fresh snow. The extremes of ice cold water or snow need to be done only after a pause to allow the pulse to settle down. Also, people with heart conditions should avoid this practice.

Traditionally sauna is done nude, participants sitting on towels for sanitary reasons. In Finland, families or close friends sauna together. Mixed sex sauna as practiced in other countries is not thought to damage the reputation of the genuine Finnish sauna. The temperature of the sauna ranges from 176 to 194 degrees F. Between rounds, have something to eat and drink according to personal taste. When finished, gradually cool down before dressing to leave. Finally, there is a strong tradition in Finland that sexuality, noisiness, and otherwise indecent behavior has not and is never to have a place in the sauna. Lake Edun fully endorses the tradition and practice of the Finns for sauna.

Oh, by the way, according to the 2000 census there are 1,933 Finns in Kansas, 3,261 in Missouri, 2,413 in Iowa, and 1,427 in Nebraska. Your challenge, should you accept it, is to find a Finn to invite to our sauna. In the meantime, most everyone enjoys a sauna, so invite a friend.

GOOD NUDITY/NUDE IS NORMAL

I like these terms. <u>Good nudity</u> and <u>nude is normal!</u> Phrases that are simple, clean, yet suggesting something intriguing, attractive, and profound. For example, nudity is appropriate between spouses in private, during a medical procedure, or in paintings and statues in an art museum. These generally accepted exceptions are further expanded within our society to a number of legal, but not as widely approved situations, such as strip bars, R rated movies, advertisements, various men's and women's mag-

azines depicting nudity, but not overt sexual behavior. All in all, a very mixed bag.

People seem to develop and very passionately defend beliefs about the uncovered human body. Complicating and intertwined with these beliefs are legitimate safety concerns for children and women who have experienced abuse at the hands of predators. There can be no minimizing of the harm done to those that have this experience. That being said, the unclothed human body is not the causative factor behind such terrible abuse. As has been amply documented elsewhere, power and control is the issue for predators, not sex, nor dress or lack thereof.

What nudists need to counter all the confusion rampant in society is a way to cut through the misperceptions, fears, and irrational hostility toward simple nudity. Nudists have been trying to do this for over a century with varying degrees of success. Obviously, no one idea, argument, or demonstration will satisfy all who currently object to non

sexual social nudity. Yet, as the saying goes, "If at first you don't succeed, try, try again."

The following are two interesting efforts to advocate for good nudity. In the first, David Goines uses the term, "Nude is Normal," to denote the positive emphasis he is promoting.

Fearing more naughty and nasty – these less than optimum advocates for humanity now scream for NONE (no nude), failing to realize that this only opens the door of opportunity for naughty and nasty to prevail itself upon humanity!

We would like to take this opportunity to remind humanity of the Good Nude that they are, as reminded by each and every nude birth upon the earth that indeed Divine Creation might have had something better in mind for this more normal, natural, state of being for humanity. We should not cover it up in disgust but seek to Celebrate Life and Living in this NEW Improved Garden Experience that indeed, humanity might become the something MORE of and for themselves instead of the Less that we too can be!

I think it is very curious that Religion for what ever reason chooses NOT to remind humanity of their profound potential for GOOD and beauty (as the Creator intended) instead seemly to damn humanity to something less! Your good nude is indeed a fine Gift of Divine Creation and becomes an entitlement of birth-right unless of course you decide to squander the Gift instead of Celebrating the Gift of some normal nude of and for yourself. Please don't let someone turn vour beautiful new Garden Experience into a living hell of un-right dominion and damnation. This then too is the responsibility of the New Garden Experience! And the special Gift that it is!

Another excellent proponent of good nudity, is Jeff Bowman. Jeff, who is a pastor, advocates for good nudity from the perspective of his personal experience and understanding of the Bible. At this point I must address two common ideas about nakedness. First, "Doesn't modesty imply that nakedness is wrong?" Modesty actually deals with what is put on the body, not what taken off or absent. When we say a person has a modest income we are describing the small amount they make. The word modest is only found in I Timothy 2:9 (KJV). It is the translation of KOSMIOS from which family of Greek words that we get our words cosmos, and cosmetic. It means the arrangement of things, their orderliness. Applied to people it would be clothes or other 'add ons' that are considered excessive by culture. Such excess can only be culturally defined. Second, can nakedness cause lust?" No, lust is caused in the heart of people by their own sin. Lust is a strong word denoting an "I've got to have it" and "I'll get it whatever way I have to" mentality. A house, or job can be an object of lust. So can a fully clothed person. Also, those in the health field, who are

around good nudity can attest that a nude patient is simply that, a nude patient.

Good nudity is so foreign to most Americans. What we typically see is what I would call bad nudity. This nudity is on a voyeuristic level, in the pages of sex magazines and sex movies. Such bad nudity is meant to sexually entice or allure. Good nudity acknowledges and celebrates the differences in each human in a non-sexual way. In other countries nude swimming, public bathing and even nude recreation is accepted. In some cultures nudity is a way of life due to very practical climate conditions. Because of this the body is demystified for people (much like a doctor or nurse who sees nudity in a non-sexual environment) and the curiosity to "look and see" is fulfilled. Today the same curiosity exists in the hearts of people and is typically met by viewing bad nudity. It is my suggestion that if we had more exposure to non-sexual nudity the "lust" factor would decline in our hearts. We would see the creation of God as good and we would view the body not as an object of voyeuristic sexuality, but as the wonderful creation it is. Good nudity is found in our art museums and art books.

Life is seen and the body is viewed naturally. Michelangelo, commissioned by the church, painted the Sistine Chapel and created larger than life sculptures with good nudity.

David and Jeff are firm believers in the intrinsic goodness of the body. They are speaking out against the forces in culture and religion that have come together to create shame of our natural selves, enforcing this with the weight of the state. Simple, non-sexual, family oriented social nudity does not promote social disorder, crime, or bring out the worst in human nature. On the contrary, the current social and moral order is rife with all the evils the enforcement of clothing is supposed to prevent. Given the prevailing cultural belief system about the nude body, it is counter intuitive to assert that the remedy for the evils society is trying to end, is in fact the freeing of the natural human body from the current constraints, and permit simple social nudity in more settings. The larger society needs to be reminded of the adage that if something isn't working, try something different. Something different is frequently the opposite of what isn't working.
